**Classification:** Director of Behavioral Health Services

**Salary Range:** \$6,517 to \$7,957 per month

*For Fiscal Year 2011/12 and 2012/13, all County employees will be given a mandatory 15 day furlough (prorated based upon date of hire) which equates to a 6% pay reduction to the monthly rates listed above.*

**Closing Date:** Open until filled

**The Position:** Under administrative direction, to develop, implement and administer public behavioral health services programs for County residents in accordance with local, state and federal laws and regulations; to supervise support and contract staff in the provision of these services; and to perform related duties as assigned.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Only candidates who demonstrate that they meet the following education and/or experience requirements will be considered for the testing and/or interview process.

**Education:** Master's Degree in psychology, counseling, psychiatric social work, nursing or related behavioral science.

**Experience:** Must meet the State criteria of Article 8 Section 620 of Title 9, for appointment as Director of Mental Health.

**Other Requirements:** Must possess a California driver's license and have a satisfactory driving record.

## Tuolumne County Benefit & Employment Information Management Unit

<b>Cafeteria Plan:</b>	Tuolumne County pays for up to family coverage for PERS Medical, Delta Dental and MES Vision. 100% of this allowance may be taken as taxable cash with proof of other insurance coverage.
<b>CalPERS Retirement:</b>	The County pays 100% of the employee's CalPERS contribution. Our current retirement formula is 2% @ 55. In addition, we contract for the Employer Paid Member Contribution benefit, which means that an additional 9% of salary for Safety and an additional 7% of salary for Non-Safety will be reported to PERS.
<b>Social Security:</b>	Tuolumne County participates in the Federal Social Security plan.
<b>Life Insurance:</b>	A County paid \$100,000 policy is provided to members of the Management Unit. Supplemental life coverage is also available.
<b>Deferred Compensation:</b>	Multiple plan providers available, including CalPERS.
<b>Annual Leave Accruals:</b>	240 hours of Personal Leave (increases with years of service per MOU) and 80 hours of Management Leave.
<b>Holidays:</b>	11 Fixed Holidays
<b>Credit Union:</b>	Tuolumne County employees may apply for membership with Financial Center Credit Union or Valley First Credit Union.
<b>Direct Deposit:</b>	Tuolumne County requires all employees to have their payroll checks direct deposited to the financial institution of their choice.
<b>Probationary Period:</b>	Positions in this unit are subject to a one year probationary period.
<b>Examination:</b>	Applicants' qualifications will be reviewed and those meeting or exceeding the minimum qualifications will be notified to participate in the examination process. The Human Resources Director may limit the number of applicants admitted to the examination process.
<b>Reasonable Accommodation:</b>	If you have a physical or mental condition, which requires us to make a reasonable accommodation for the testing process, please contact the Human Resources Department immediately.
<b>Medical Examination:</b>	Applicants may be required to take a medical examination including drug screen prior to appointment to a position. Failure to meet medical standards may result in termination or withdrawal of appointment.
<b>Immigration Law:</b>	Upon hire applicants must meet documentation requirements of the Immigration Reform Act of 1986.

### **Local Recreation**

Tuolumne County is home to endless year round recreational opportunities. During winter, you can ski and snowboard at Dodge Ridge, snowmobile in the high country, or ice skate at Long Barn.

You'll never be bored in the summertime! Our county is home to boating and fishing on Lake Don Pedro, New Melones Reservoir, Tulloch Lake, Cherry Lake, Lyons Lake, and smaller high country lakes which can be reached by hiking or during a pack trip into the Emigrant Wilderness. Go whitewater rafting on our world famous Class 1 – 5 rapids, or take a lazy float trip in neighboring Knights Ferry. Camping, hiking, biking, and off road vehicle opportunities are endless.

We're also the proud home of Columbia State Historic Park, the best preserved Gold Rush town in the Mother Lode region, and Railtown 1897 Historic State Park in Jamestown, where you can ride the train at one of the last operating railroad roundhouses.
